Six years ago, the US Supreme Court

ruled that some strip searches might go "too far", possibly violating a child's rights.

But, the judges did not define "too far". Not only that, but shockingly, there is no requirement that school officials even tell you that they strip searched your child. You might not find out until weeks later.

We understand that there may be a situation that calls for the personal search of a student. But at those rare times, we feel the search must be carried out by a uniformed police officer of the same gender. Obviously, police are trained to respect our constitutionally protected rights. Further, we feel that the school needs to notify parents as soon as the decision to conduct the search is made.

But the Bethlehem School Board is refusing to implement such a policy!
